



## **TWO (2) x YELLOW CARD** **PROCEDURE**

Please find listed below, the clarification of when a player has received Two (2) Yellow cards during the course of a game.

- If a player was to receive Two (2) Yellow cards for **the same offence or for two different offences** during the course of the game, then the player will be shown a Red card and will be ordered off the field, the offender shall take no further part in the game and cannot be replaced for 15 minutes.

This warrants for a one (1) week's prescribed penalty, as found in the WAFC Rules and Regulations policy 15E 2b. The prescribed penalty will be initiated by the official Umpires of the game and recorded on the Match Day App at the completion of the game played.

- If a player was to have received Two (2) Yellow cards during the course of the season and if a Third (3) Yellow card is received, then the Competition Management will implement the offending player with a One (1) week's suspension for their actions and for each successive yellow card received thereafter.

Please Note:

If and when a player was to receive a Third (3) Yellow card during the course of the home and away season, then the player will be sent off for the 15-minute cool off time and can return to play at the completion of the 15-minute cool off time.
