



## Parents and Guardians Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all parents and guardians of registered Junior and Youth players.

- Encourage children to participate, if they are interested
- Encourage children to always participate according to the rules
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn best from example.
- If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the official's judgment and honesty in public.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Recognise the value and importance of volunteer coaches.
- Remember that children play organised sports for fun. They are not playing for entertainment of spectators only, nor are they miniature professionals.
- Condemn the use of violence in any form, be it by spectators, coaches, officials or players.
- Encourage players to follow the rules and the umpire's decisions.
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches or umpires.

By registering our child at Hammond Park Football Club I agree to abide by these principles.

I support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary actions including the suspension and banning where warranted of any coaches for repeated or serious breaches of the Parents Code of Conduct.

I also support the club in any disciplinary actions related to players including the suspension or banning of players, for either repeated or serious breaches of the player's code of conduct.

## Players Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all registered Junior and Youth players.

- Play by the rules (of both the laws of the game and the rules of my club.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, discuss the matter with your coach after the game.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, or provoking an opponent is not acceptable.
- Work equally hard for yourself and for your team. Your team’s performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they are by your team, opponent or the other team.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Cooperate with your coach, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Play for the “fun of the game” and not just to please parents and coaches.
- Avoid using derogatory language.
- Be prepared to take responsibility for your actions.
